Adenoviruses are double-stranded DNA viruses with a genome of ~34–43 kb, a size that is amenable for easy manipulation. The virus compensates for its small genome by encoding polypeptides from both DNA strands and by alternative splicing and the use of different poly (A) sites.

Their name derives from their initial isolation from human adenoids in 1953. They have a broad range of vertebrate hosts; in humans, more than 50 distinct adenoviral serotypes have been found to cause a wide range of illnesses, from mild respiratory infections in young children to life-threatening multi-organ disease in people with a weakened immune system.

The structure of an adenovirus virion is simple, consisting of a capsid, fibers, a core, and associated proteins. A protein core inside the outer icosahedral protein capsid contains the genome.
